We closed on 7508 Hamilton Avenue. We will continue to work on this. 7500 Hamilton Avenue is scheduled to close later in the month. We will continue the relationship with Remax for property management.

The updated final summer schedule is out. Very excited about it. Lots of great things will be happening in the park this summer. Monica and Ray are doing a great job on this. Every year the Corvair club makes a \$300 donation in exchange for their meetings at the community room. In the past it was used for different things in the park. This year they are going to sponsor an event in the park and they chose to sponsor the Ohio Military Band. "Thanks" to the Corvair club for their donation.

We are still looking at ordinances for the foreclosure property registration. We are looking for one that has been used and has worked. We hope to get something for council to review and then be able to move forward with this.

Detective Jones and the Mt. Healthy Police Department would like to host this year's National Night Out held on August 4th from 5:30pm to 8:00pm. This can strengthen neighborhood spirit and police-community partnerships and sends a message to criminals letting them know that neighborhoods are organized and fighting back.


Summer Schedule is coming up. Council will need to make the decision on this.
