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RESOLUTION NO. 16-1085

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION ON BEHALF OF THE MT. HEALTHY CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT TO PARTICIPATE IN THE STATE OF OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL TRAVEL PLAN GRANT PROGRAM AND TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS AS REQUIRED AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

The following resolution is enacted by the City of Mt. Healthy, Hamilton County, Ohio, hereinafter referred to as the Applicant, in the matter of the stated described project.

**WHEREAS**, the United States Congress has set aside monies for Safe Routes to School Projects through the State of Ohio, Department of Transportation; and

**WHEREAS**, Applicants can apply for these monies and be selected for funding by the State of Ohio, Department of Transportation; and

**WHEREAS**, the School Travel Plan is an activity eligible to receive federal transportation funding; and

**NOW THEREFORE**, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MT. HEALTHY, STATE OF OHIO:

**Section 1**, The City Manager of said Applicant is hereby empowered on behalf of the Applicant to prepare and execute an application for SRTS School Travel Plan Development for the stated described project and to submit same to the State of Ohio, Department of Transportation.

**Section 2,** If awarded the project, no funding will be reimbursed to applicants for School Travel Plan Development. Applicants will be asked to provide information, develop a team, and work with ODOT on plan development. The Applicant further agrees to pay One Hundred Percent (100%) of the cost over and above the work provided by the State of Ohio, Department of Transportation.

**Section 3,** Upon completion of the described Project, the Applicant shall:  
Provide completed School Travel Plan with adequate community endorsements.

**Section 4,** If the application is approved for the STP Development the City Manager of said Applicant is hereby empowered on behalf of the LPA to enter into a contract with the Director of the Ohio Department of Transportation necessary to complete the above described project.

**Section 5,** That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare and will take effect immediately upon its passage. The reason for the emergency is to meet the application deadline.
