**MT. HEALTHY SELECTS NEW SUPPLIER AND NEW LOW RATE FOR ELECTRIC AGGREGATION PROGRAM**

**Mt. Healthy, Ohio (February, 2017)** – Mt. Healthy officials are pleased to announce that they have selected IGS Energy to serve the next term of the City's electric aggregation program. The City has set a fixed rate of 5.47 cents/kWh for a 3-year term starting with April 2017 meter reads. Residents and small businesses should look for a mailer to arrive on or about February 24, 2017 concerning the new electric aggregation program offer from IGS Energy.

"The mailer will explain the low offer we negotiated and the means to opt-out should a customer not want to participate in the program," said Bill Kocher, City Manager of Mt. Healthy. Residents will have 21 days to return an opt-out card to IGS Energy, if they decide not to participate. Kocher concluded by saying, "We're excited about the 36-month offer of 5.47 cents/kWh. That rate is considerably lower than the alternative from Duke Energy and we expect participation levels in our program to be high. This low rate will allow residents to predict their costs and will protect them from rising rates for the next three years. Our new rate is very attractive, and as before our program has no early termination fee."

Mark Burns, president of Independent Energy Consultants, added that residents who have already chosen a supplier on their own will receive a similar letter from IGS Energy inviting them to join the program and get the same rate, terms, and conditions as their neighbors. These residents will have to contact IGS in order to join the program, and should review their current supply contracts to make sure there are no early termination fees.

Mt. Healthy is pleased to have made this program possible but asks that you do not call the City offices. They are not equipped to handle a large volume of calls. If residents have any questions, they should contact IGS Energy at 877-353-0162 after they receive their letter.
