ORDINANCE NO. 17-1816

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY CLERK TO EXECUTE ALL FORMS NECESSARY TO APPLY FOR GRANT FUNDING FOR SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL FOR THE PURCHASE OF A RADAR FEEDBACK SIGN

The following is an Ordinance enacted by the Council of the City of Mt. Healthy of Hamilton County, Ohio, hereinafter referred to as the Applicant in the matter of the stated described project.

WHEREAS, the United States Congress has set aside monies for Safe Routes to School (SRTS) Projects through the State of Ohio, Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, Applicants can apply for these monies and be selected for funding by the State of Ohio, Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, the purchase of a SafePace 100 11" Radar Feedback Sign to aid in reducing speed at targeted, identified locations to increase the safety for walking and biking, is an activity eligible to receive federal transportation funding; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MT. HEALTHY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. The City Clerk of said Applicant is hereby empowered on behalf of the Applicant to prepare and execute an application for SRTS funds for the stated described project and to submit same to the State of Ohio, Department of Transportation.

Section 2. The total cost of the project is estimated to be \$2,759.00 of which the Applicant, if awarded the funds, agrees to pay One Hundred Percent (100%) of the cost over and above the maximum amount provided by the State of Ohio, Department of Transportation.

Section 3. Upon completion of the described Project, the Applicant shall: (1) provide adequate reports and verification of work performed; and (2) provide detailed plan for sustaining project once funding is concluded.

Section 4. If the application is approved for the funding the City Manager of said Applicant is hereby empowered on behalf of the Council of the City of Mt. Healthy to enter into a contract with the Director of the Ohio Department of Transportation necessary to complete the above described project.

Section 5. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure to take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage to meet the Safe Routes to School application requirements.
