For those Mt. Healthy residents who do not donate unused clothing, shoes and home goods such as kitchenware, books, small toys, etc. The City of Mt. Healthy is teaming up with "Simple Recycling" so residents will soon be able to recycle unwanted clothing, shoes, and home goods with free, curbside pick-up on regular trash collection day. The EPA estimates 85% of textiles are NOT recycled or donated. This is another way to keep these types of materials out of the landfill. Mt. Healthy Pool Passes available now!

Mt. Healthy Pool Passes are available at the City Building, 7700 Perry Street, 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday. All passes are discounted if you purchase them before the pool opens in June. Resident family passes are \$132.00 if you get them before the pool opens. You save \$33.00 off the regular price of \$165.00! Non-resident family passes are \$164.00 pre-season, \$205.00 if purchased after the pool opens. Now is a good time to save some bucks by getting your pool passes early!

Assumption Festival Safety Measures 2017

Several safety enhancements have been made to help keep this a safe and fun event:

Dates of the event are

June 9: 6pm-11pm

June 10: 5pm-11pm

June 11: 1pm-9pm

- Event site and adjacent areas are now monitored by camera surveillance
- Event monitors will be provided by Overflow Ministry
- **Curfew to begin at 9:00pm for juveniles 16 years of age or younger**, who are not with a parent or legal guardian, actively working, or leaving the event area. Curfew for those 17 years of age will begin at 10:00pm. The curfew will be enforced in the area between Adams Road, Kinney Avenue, Harrison Avenue, and Seward Avenue.
- **Juveniles under 18 will not be admitted after 9:00 pm without a parent or legal guardian**
- No alcohol will be permitted outside of the event area
- Gang related apparel will not be permitted
- No weapons of any kind are permitted
- No Glass bottles
- \$2.00 entry fee with no re-entry
