RESOLUTION NO. 17-1107

A RESOLUTION OPPOSING THE RENEWAL OF THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF LIQUOR CONTROL LICENSE FOR THE SPEEDWAY CONVENIENCE STORE #9585 LOCATED AT 7300 HAMILTON AVENUE DBA SPEEDWAY LLC, ANTHONY KENNEY PRESIDENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Mt. Healthy Police Department has received numerous calls with complaints of disorder and illegal conduct by patrons of this establishment to which the ownership has failed to cooperate in the investigation thereof with police as partially shown in the attached listing compiled by the Mt. Healthy Police Department; and

WHEREAS, these complaints involve drug violations, numerous calls for service relative to Robbery, Assault, Menacing, Disorderly Conduct, Theft, Discharging Firearms, Auto Thefts, Fights with Guns, Intoxicated Individuals taking place on the premises; and

WHEREAS, such conduct caused panic and alarm to members of our community disrupting the peace and tranquility thereof.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MT. HEALTHY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. The City of Mt. Healthy hereby opposes the renewal of a liquor license to the business at 7300 Hamilton Avenue DBA Speedway LLC, Anthony Kenney President.

Section 2. The Clerk of Council is hereby directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to the Ohio Department of Commerce Division of Liquor Control.

Section 3. This resolution is declared an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety. The reason for the emergency is that immediate passage is necessary to present opposition to the renewal of the Ohio Department of Liquor Control permit for the premises in question. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.

- 1-Unconscious Intoxicated


From January 1, 2016, through January 1, 2017, officers were on scene 458 times including 255 safety checks and the following 41 criminal offenses:

- 1-Shots Fired
- 25-Theft Offenses
- 1-Assault

3-Auto Thefts
4-Intoxicated Individuals
2-Fights with Guns
2-Heroin OD
2-Traffic Stops with 1 gun recovery
1 Juvenile Offense
