RESOLUTION NO. 20-1139

A RESOLUTION OPPOSING THE RENEWAL OF THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF LIQUOR CONTROL LICENSE FOR JAE L. ABERNATHY DBA "TAKE A SHOT BAR" LOCATED AT 1357 COMPTON RD AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Mt. Healthy Police Department has received numerous calls with complaints of disorder and illegal conduct by patrons of this establishment to which the ownership has failed to cooperate in the investigation thereof with police as partially shown in the **attached** listing compiled by the Mt. Healthy Police Department; and

WHEREAS, these complaints involve 3 Felonious Assaults (shootings), numerous calls for service relative to Gambling, Assault, Menacing, Disorderly Conduct, Soliciting, Intoxicated Individuals taking place on the premises; and

WHEREAS, such conduct caused disturbing annoyance and inconvenience to members of our community disrupting the peace and tranquility thereof.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MT. HEALTHY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. The City of Mt. Healthy hereby opposes the renewal of a liquor license to the business at 1357 Compton Rd. known as Take a Shot.

Section 2. The Clerk of Council is hereby directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to the Ohio Department of Commerce Division of Liquor Control.

Section 3. This resolution is declared an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety. The reason for the emergency is that immediate passage is necessary to present opposition to the renewal of the Ohio Department of Liquor Control permit for the premises in question. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.


19 additional nuisance details were also documented.

62 safety checks have been performed on the businesses in the strip mall

Officers have been on scene 114 times since June 6, 2019. We have met with staff at the bar and discussed concerns of safety, litter, parking, and crowd control. At this point we have not seen any attempt on behalf of the bar ownership to enact policy which will correct the issues and a serious public safety threat exists at this location.
